Getting to and from the station:

Kirkby Stephen station is 1½ miles west of Kirkby Stephen, on the main A685 Tebay road.

ON FOOT From Kirkby Stephen town there is a tarmac public footpath across the fields, walking time around 30 minutes.

BY BIKE The footpath is also suitable for cyclists. There are no official cycle storage facilities at the station.

BY BUS There are regular buses linking the station with the town centre on Mondays to Saturdays, but none on Sundays.

Cumbria Classic Coaches (01539 623 254). Heritage buses from the station upper car park.

Tuesdays only: (until 25 October 2011) Ravenstonedale - Kirkby Stephen station at 1035 - Kirkby Stephen town - Hawes; Hawes - Kirkby Stephen town - station at 1615 - Ravenstonedale.

Wednesdays only: Ravenstonedale - Kirkby Stephen station at 1035 - town - Barnard Castle; Barnard Castle - Kirkby Stephen town - station at 1622 (until 26 October, 1522 from 2 November 2011) - Ravenstonedale.

Kirkby Lonsdale Coaches, service 564 linking the town and station with Kendal, from the bus stop on the main road by the station entrance.

Arrivals from the town: *Mondays to Saturdays* 0710 (no 0710 on Saturdays), 0945, 1240, 1515, 1805.

Departures to the town: *Mondays to Saturdays* 0927, 1157, 1500, 1727. (01524 733 831 - Kirkby Lonsdale Coaches).
